

Zoom Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Click on the Zoom link that you received in your reminder email.
- 2. This will take you to a Zoom registration form that looks like this:

3. Complete the Zoom form using the name and email address that we have on file, eg the email address that you used to register that is linked to your AIBS account and then click 'Register. You may also need to tick 'I'm not a robot' but this depends on the internet browser that you are using.



4. If you receive an error from Zoom advising 'authorised users only', it is informing you that it does not like the format of the email address you are using, eg @yourstate.gov.au or @yourcouncil.gov.au. Consider using a different email address.

Another reason could be that the email address has been used numerous times without having a Zoom account created. If this happens, please complete the form using a different email address, for example your personal email address then click 'Register'. If you do use a personal email address, please send an email to <u>training@aibs.com.au</u> to advise of this so we can allocate your CPD correctly.
